Project Overview

On Monday, April 27, 2009, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Six, will begin an Advanced Warning System Project along Brickell Avenue / U.S. 1 / State Road (S.R. 5) from south of SE 15th Road to SE 5th Street.

This project includes installing an Advanced Warning System, designed to provide motorists with advanced notification when the Brickell Avenue Bridge is in the open position. Warning signs are anticipated to be installed at four locations along Brickell Avenue, as well as SE 8th Street. Sign locations are as follows:

- Brickell Avenue northbound; south of SE 15th Road
Motorists have the option to make a left at SE 15th Road, Coral Way (SE 13th Street) or SE 10th Street.
- Brickell Avenue northbound; south of Coral Way (SE 13th Street)
Motorists have the option to make a left at Coral Way (SE 13th Street) or SE 10th Street.
- Brickell Avenue northbound; south of SE 10th Street
Motorists have the option to make a left at SE 7th Street.
- SE 8th Street westbound; east of Brickell Bay Drive
Motorists have the option to make a left at Brickell Bay Drive.

This project will last approximately four months and cost an estimated \$340,000. Please note that bad weather, or other unforeseen circumstances, could impact this schedule.

Traffic Flow

It may be necessary to close travel lanes in order to perform this work safely. Lane closures may occur during day and nighttime hours as follows:

- 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. – Sunday through Saturday
- 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. – Sunday through Thursday
- 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. – Friday and Saturday

At least one lane will remain open in both directions and access to bus stop locations, residences and businesses will be maintained at all times.
