**Brickell Avenue Construction Update**

Dear **Natalie Brown**,

**For your safety please walk, drive and ride cautiously around construction zones and do not enter any closed work zones.**

There will be no work performed from Thursday, November 24 through Sunday, November 27 in observance of Thanksgiving.

**Upcoming Construction Activities:**

The contractor will continue working at the intersection of Brickell Avenue and SE 8 Street in order to finalize the sanitary sewer installation and roadway restoration. Work will take place from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday. At least one lane in each direction will remain open at all times. Minor detours may be used as needed when the contractor must temporarily close a lane along Brickell Avenue or SE 8 Street. Signs will be posted on the roadway to direct drivers around the construction.

Several turning movements will be limited the weekend of December 3 at the intersection of Brickell Avenue and SE 8 Street. A detour will be used to guide drivers around the work continuously through the weekend while the contractor continues underground utility work. The detour will be from 8 a.m. Saturday, December 3 through 5 a.m. on Monday, December 5. In order to perform this work safely, certain traffic at the intersection of Brickell Avenue SE 8 Street will be detoured. Only the turning movements listed below will be affected. A minimum of one travel lane will remain open at all times along southbound Brickell Avenue. Signs will be posted on the roadway to direct drivers around the construction.

Drivers going southbound on Brickell Avenue who wish to turn east on SE 8 Street will have to:

- Continue south on Brickell Avenue
- Turn east on SE 14 Street
- Turn north on Brickell Bay Drive
- Turn east on SE 8 Street

Drivers going eastbound on SE 8 Street who wish to continue east on SE 8 Street will have to:

- Turn south on Brickell Avenue
- Turn east at SE 14 Street
- Turn north on Brickell Bay Drive
- Turn east on SE 8 Street

Drivers going eastbound on SE 8 Street who wish to turn north on Brickell Avenue will have to:

- Turn south on Brickell Avenue
- Turn east on SE 14 Street
- Turn north on Brickell Bay Drive
- Turn west on SE 8 Street
- Turn north on Brickell Avenue

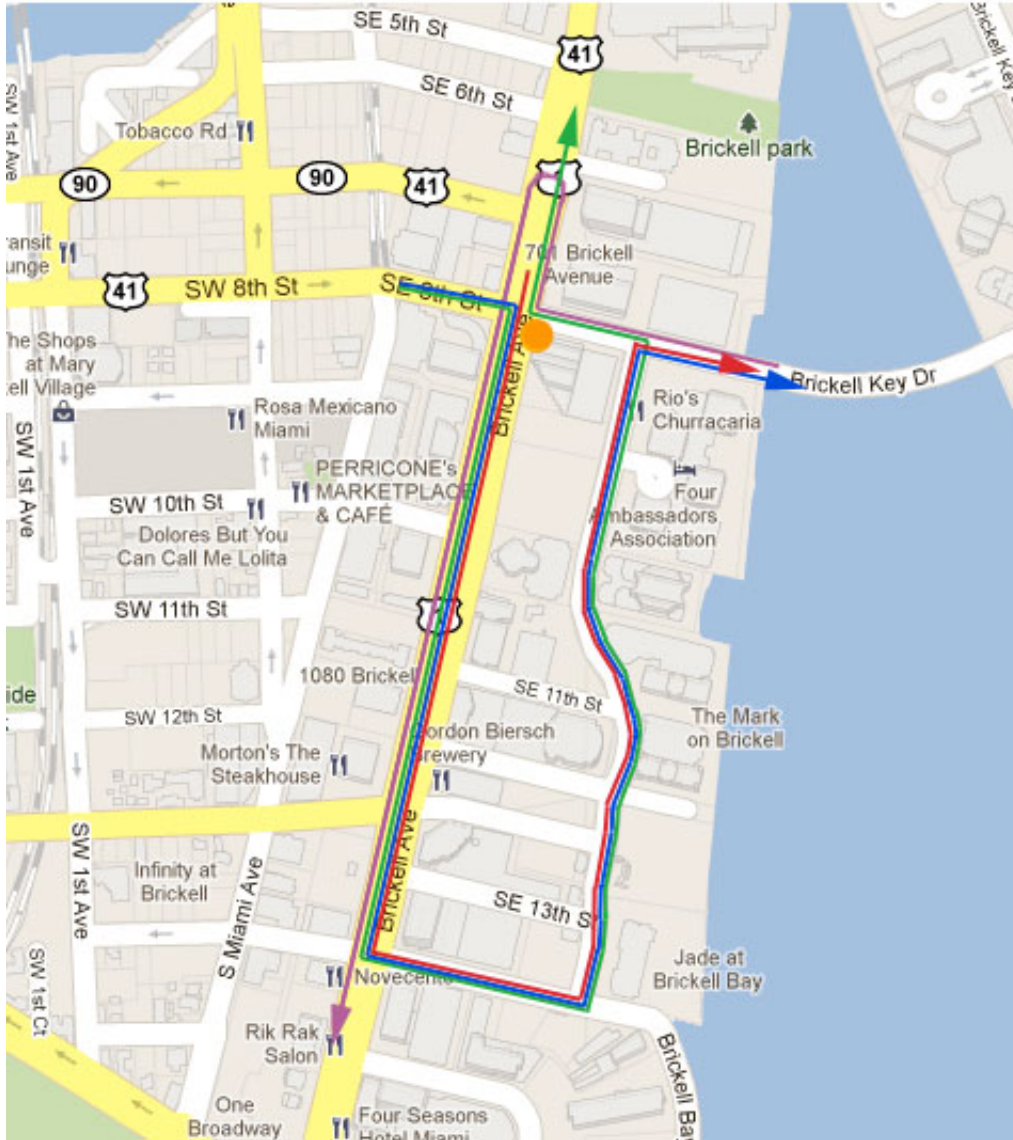
Drivers going westbound on SE 8 Street who wish to turn south on Brickell Avenue will have to:

- Turn north on Brickell Avenue
- Make a u-turn at SE 7 Street
- Continue south on Brickell Avenue

- ➔ Drivers going southbound on Brickell Avenue who wish to turn east on SE 8 Street
- ➔ Drivers going eastbound on SE 8 Street who wish to continue east on SE 8 Street
- ➔ Drivers going eastbound on SE 8 Street who wish to turn north on Brickell Avenue
- ➔ Drivers going westbound on SE 8 Street who wish to turn south on Brickell Avenue

A minimum of one travel lane will remain open on southbound and northbound Brickell Avenue at all times.



The contractor will continue replacing slabs of concrete pavement on Brickell Avenue at SE 13 Street/SE 12 Terrace. Work will take place from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Mondays through Fridays. At least one lane in each direction will remain open at all times. Minor detours may be used as needed when the contractor must temporarily close a lane along Brickell Avenue or SE 13 Street/SE 12 Terrace. Signs will be posted on the roadway to direct drivers around the construction.

A permanent work zone with barrier wall and barricades has been established along SE 12 Street from Brickell Avenue to Brickell Bay Drive. Only westbound traffic will be able to travel along SE 12 Street while

the contractor installs several underground drainage structures and a storm water force main. Eastbound traffic will be detoured. Drivers who want to travel east on SE 12 Street will have to turn east on SE 12 Terrace, turn north on Brickell Bay Drive and turn west on SE 12 Street. Signs will be posted on the roadway to direct drivers around the construction. On-street parking along SE 12 Street will be eliminated during this time. Access to driveways will be maintained at all times. This work is scheduled through the end of the year.

A permanent work zone with barricades has been established within the cul-de-sac on SE 12 Street, east of Brickell Bay Drive, in order to install two underground storm water drainage structures. Travel lanes along SE 12 Street in this area will not be affected. Access to driveways will be maintained at all times. This work is scheduled through December 1.

A permanent work zone with barrier wall and barricades has been established in the median of Brickell Avenue between SE 13 Street and SE 12 Street in order to install a new pump station and water main. Along Brickell Avenue in this area two northbound and southbound travel lanes are open for motorists.

One northbound lane and one southbound lane will be closed at times along Brickell Avenue between SE 15 Road and SE 5 Street while the contractor performs concrete, lighting and drainage work in the area. The closure will be from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. One lane may also be closed from 8 a.m. Saturday to 5 a.m. Monday. This work is scheduled through February 2012. At least one lane in both directions will remain open at all times.

Sections of one northbound lane on Brickell Avenue will be closed at times from SE 25 Road to SE 15 Road, Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. through February 2012, while the contractor replaces slabs of concrete pavement. At least one lane in the northbound direction will remain open at all times.

Sections of one southbound lane on Brickell Avenue will be closed at times from SE 25 Road to SE 15 Road, Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and 8 a.m. to 5 a.m. Saturday through Monday morning, through February 2012, while the contractor replaces slabs of concrete pavement. At least one lane in the southbound direction will remain open at all times.
