Brickell Avenue Construction Update

Dear **Natalie Brown**,

For your safety please walk, drive and ride cautiously around construction zones and do not enter any closed work zones.

Upcoming Construction Activities:

The weekend work at the intersection of Brickell Avenue and SE 8 Street is complete and no additional weekend detours are anticipated. The final underground sanitary sewer installation and roadway restoration at this intersection will take place from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Mondays through Fridays. At least one lane in each direction will remain open at all times. Minor detours may be used as needed when the contractor must temporarily close a turn lane along Brickell Avenue or SE 8 Street. Signs will be posted on the roadway to direct drivers around the construction.

A permanent work zone with barrier wall and barricades has been established along SE 12 Street from Brickell Avenue to Brickell Bay Drive. Only westbound traffic will be able to travel along SE 12 Street while the contractor installs several underground drainage structures and a storm water force main. Eastbound traffic will be detoured. Drivers who want to travel east on SE 12 Street will have to turn east on SE 12 Terrace, turn north on Brickell Bay Drive and turn west on SE 12 Street. Signs will be posted on the roadway to direct drivers around the construction. On-street parking along SE 12 Street will be eliminated during this time. Access to driveways will be maintained at all times. This work is currently scheduled through October 2011.

A permanent work zone with barrier wall and barricades has been established in the median of Brickell Avenue between SE 13 Street to SE 12 Street in order to install a new pump station and water main. Along Brickell Avenue in this area:

- Between SE 13 Street and SE 12 Street there are two southbound travel lanes open and one northbound travel lane open. The closed northbound travel lane is expected to be reopened by early October 2011.

Use caution in this area and we encourage drivers to seek alternate routes.

One northbound lane and one southbound lane will be closed at times along Brickell Avenue between SE 15 Road and SE 13 Street while the contractor performs concrete, lighting and drainage work in the area. The closure will be from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. One lane may also be closed from 8 a.m. Saturday to 5 a.m. Monday. This work is scheduled through February 2012. At least one lane in both directions will remain open at all times.

Sections of one northbound lane on Brickell Avenue will be closed at times from SE 25 Road to SE 15 Road, Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. through February 2012, while the contractor replaces slabs of concrete pavement. At least one lane in the northbound direction will remain open at all times.

Sections of one southbound lane on Brickell Avenue will be closed at times from SE 25 Road to SE 15 Road, Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and 8 a.m. to 5 a.m. Saturday through Monday morning, through February 2012, while the contractor replaces slabs of concrete pavement. At least one lane in the southbound direction will remain open at all times.
