This is to inform you that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a Public Information Meeting for the Brickell Avenue Concrete Repair and Restoration Project from SE 25th Road to SE 5th Street along SR 5/Brickell Avenue **on Tuesday, October 30, 2007, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Presentation will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m.** The Public Information Meeting will be held at the **Miami Science Museum, 3280 South Miami Avenue, Miami, Florida 33129.** See the attached map for meeting location.

The purpose of this Public Information Meeting is to provide property owners and interested parties an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed roadway improvements being developed. Proposed project improvements include:

- Repairing existing concrete pavement to meet FDOT standards
- Diamond grinding to improve the riding surface of the existing concrete pavement
- Improving drainage problems at the following locations:
 - SE 15th Road/Brickell Avenue Intersection
 - SE 13th Street/Coral Way/Brickell Avenue Intersection
 - From SE 8th Street to SE 7th Street
- Repairing sidewalk, curb and gutter as needed from SE 25th Road to SE 5th Street
- Milling and resurfacing existing asphalt pavement from just west of SE 8th Street to SE 5th Street
- Upgrading existing signalization and providing a new signal at SE 10th Street
- Upgrading existing lighting from SE 15th Road to SE 5th Street
- New signing and pavement markings from SE 25th Road to SE 5th Street
- New pedestrian crossings
